Harness, helmet and all equipment used for climbing must be checked before each individual climb commences. visual confirmation and tug check must be completed for every climb to ensure rope is connected to climber correctly. Climbing calls/permission to climb must be agreed for belay team and climber. Instructor only to lower the participant down. |
