

## Risk Assessment for the wide games at Henley Fort

## Human Hazards

Hazard type	Who may be harmed	Is the risk adequately controlled
All hazards	All Participants and Staff	Site specific trained and assessed Surrey Outdoor learning and Development (S.O.L.D.) Staff only. Staff must follow operational procedures of activity sessions. See 'general' risk assessment for S.O.L.D. centre.
Slipping/Tripping	All Participants and Staff	Paths swept regularly. Clearing of leaves in winter. Groups briefed on areas safe to run. Brief visitors to be aware of surrounding environment.
Getting Lost / wandering off site	All Participants	Visitors briefed on arrival of boundaries. Fence round whole site. Main gates locked at night.
Getting Lost	All Participants	Instructors must follow guidelines on briefing participants including what to do in the event of getting lost. Use appropriate course to fit age & ability of group. S.O.L.D. staff and accompanying group leaders to patrol the site for the duration of the activity.

## **Environment Hazards**

Hazard type	Who may be harmed	Is the risk adequately controlled
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Personal injury - abrasions to skin from vegetation	All Participants and Staff	S.O.L.D. trained staff to brief, full body covering when running through vegetation or use the paths only. Warn participants about branches & stems flicking back as people push past. Ensure clients with asthma or any allergic reactions are known and appropriate medication is carried.
Personal injury - through collision or contact with other participants	All Participants and Staff	S.O.L.D. trained staff to brief, no physical contact allowed.
